The story featured the Pawnee Bill's Wild West show where they are performing as Annie Oakley and Frank Butler every Saturday though the month of June. Annie Oakley performed for only a short time with Pawnee Bill's Wild West during its first season in 1888. Annie and Buffalo Bill had come to a parting of the ways, probably due in part to a rivalry with the shooter Lillian Smith, and to the businessman Frank Butler, Pawnee Bill's Wild West was the only thing that seemed to be comparable to the job they had just left. Even though May Lillie, Pawnee Bill's wife, was also a sharpshooter for the show, Annie always received top billing.

Doug and Marna will be performing during the afternoon on June 24 in conjunction with the Pawnee Bill Historic site near the town of Pawnee Oklahoma. In addition there will be blacksmithing demonstrations, rope making, gunfighters and more.
